

Check out these ways that you can get involved!

PRINCESS NIGHT STREET OUTREACH

PARTICIPANT FEMALE MAKE CARDS ALL

3-12 hours/month Attend street outreach, lifting up the city in prayer, offering a rose and encouragement to the ladies we meet

DOORMAN MALE PRAYER WARRIOR ALL

3-6 hours/month Attend street outreach and serve as doormen to provide security to women volunteers and engage with men with love and hope Pray for special requests throughout the

Create encouraging cards to be handed out

to each woman we meet; guidelines provided

Minimum of 30 minutes

JAIL

PEN PAL FEMALE MENTOR FEMALE

30 mins/week
Once assigned an inmate, you will write a
letter within 48 hours (your home address will
not be used); continue correspondence until
the inmate is released

30-60 mins/week, in-person and virtual Once assigned an inmate, you will meet with her either in-person or virtually dependent on the facility and offer hope and healing through mentorship

EVENTS TEAM MEMBER ALL 15-30 hours/year

Plan and implement large-scale spring and/or fall fundraisers (eg., golf event, gala)

EVENTS ALL

5-10 hours/year Complete tasks necessary to implement event, help with set up and tear down

HOST THIRD PARTY EVENTS ALL

Organize and implement a fundraising event independent of Out of Darkness (eg., yard sale, sports tournament, sale of goods)

4-8 hours/quarter

AMBASSADOR

MEDICAL TRAINING

3-6 hours/quarter

Train interprofessional healthcare providers on how to identify, assess, and assist victims of commercial sexual exploitation; must be a licensed medical professional to provide training

Represent Out of Darkness at events, answer

basic questions about the organization; speak to

churches, youth groups, community groups, etc. about human trafficking and how to get involved



PARSONS DROP-IN CENTER

PROVIDE MEALS

Minimum of 1 hour Provide the food to be used for meals on the days that the drop-in center is open; you would prepare it ahead of time and drop off, to be heated up the day being served; sign up on Signup Genius (website) to reserve a day

DONATIONS

2-3 hours/month The second Saturday of every month you would sort donations of clothing and toiletries and restock those items in the house

DROP-IN VOLUNTEER

FEMALE

4 hours/month minimum

As part of a team, serve at the drop-in center on the days that it's open; you would pray over the events of the day, prepare food, make sure that the space, clothes and toiletries are ready and support any ladies who attend that day

SAFE HOME

HOTLINE FFMALF VOLUNTEER FEMALE

Take calls from women when they are ready to leave "the life" and go to the safe home; walk them through a series of questions and dispatch a rescue team

RESCUE TEAM

Rescue team members will be contacted when a woman has called the hotline and is ready to enter the safe home; you will pick her up and transport her to the safe home; each team consists of one man and one woman

Volunteer to teach the ladies life skills. fitness, Bible study, etc.

MAINTENANCE ALL ALL

> Maintain the physical appearance of the home; needed seasonally

WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PRINCESS NIGHT OR PROVIDING A MEAL OR DONATIONS. ALL VOLUNTEERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN APPLICATION, PROVIDE A PASTORAL REFERENCE, HAVE A BACKGROUND CHECK, AND ATTEND TRAINING
